EVENT FORMAT

Pre-Final Round

- The selected students will be made to present their papers in front of student's panel consisting of PG Students .
- The presentation must be brief not exceeding a maximum of 6 minutes followed by a questionnaire session.
- Selected participants will be intimated soon after the evaluation and are eligible to attend the next round.

Final Round

- The students selected in Round 1 will have to present their papers in front of highly skilled judge panel consisting of professors.
- Eight (8) minutes shall be allotted for the oral presentation and four (4) minutes for questions , however these times are subject to change depending on the number of participants any time prior to the start of the contest.

- The paper contest organizer shall arrange a timing system, with the following characteristics:
- A signal will be given at the beginning of the oral presentation.
- A first warning signal will be given halfway through the presentation period.
- A second warning signal will be given two minutes prior to the end of the presentation period.
- A stop signal will be given at the end of the presentation period.

General

- Certificates and prizes will be awarded to the top scorers based on the criteria decided by the judges. Decision of judges shall be final and it will be binding to all.
- If a participant does not abide by any of the aforementioned rules, his/her team will be disqualified automatically.
- Only a maximum of three authors are permitted per paper.
- Only one abstract per author is permitted.
- The full length papers must be submitted in IEEE format and should not exceed 6 pages.
- Selected participants alone will be presenting their paper in the final round.
- All the authors of the selected papers must do on-site registration on the day of event in order to present their papers.
- Certificates will be issued only to those participants, who presents their paper on-site.
- Certificates and prizes will be awarded to the best paper presentations based on the criteria decided by the judges. Decision of judges shall be final and it will be binding to all.
- Any non-disciplinary action within the college premises will be viewed seriously and the participant will be disqualified.

- If a participant does not abide by any of the above mentioned rules, his/her paper will be disqualified automatically.
